## **INTRODUCTION**

6	be familiar with and uphold the ethical principles and requirements of the ACFID Code of Conduct ( <a href="https://acfid.asn.au/content/read-code">https://acfid.asn.au/content/read-code</a> ) and undertake the on-line training Introduction to ACFID Code of Conduct, where appropriate;
7	commit to the safeguarding of children and other vulnerable people as outlined in ADFA's Child Safeguarding and Prevention of Sexual Exploitation, Abuse and Harassment policies, and comply with the responsibilities within, including completing prescribed on-line training, where appropriate;
8	not directly or indirectly divulge to any person or use confidential information of ADFA for my own or another's benefit;
9	comply with occupational health and safety requirements in the workplace as set out in ADFA's Occupational Health and Safety Policy;
10	consent to photos taken of myself during my tenure may be used by ADFA for promotional or training purposes; and
